How to participate?

Applicants should request an application form and the rules from Ms Sabrina Keller (sabrina.keller@merial.com).

Applications should concern the management of pain in leisure and companion animals and have to be presented in a format suitable for publication.

The jury will evaluate

- originality of the case (technique, illness, treatment, ...)
- description of the complete diagnostic procedure
- pain management procedure/objective criteria of objective measurement criteria
- follow-up of the animal (scientific evaluation, method of scoring, ...)
- literature review, the iconography
- structure of the article

The application has to be made by a veterinarian, in English.

It has to include a short abstract (max 500 words) + the full case/publication and has to be sent in an electronic format to Ms Agnès Vidal (agnes.vidal@merial.com) indicating "Merial Pain Management Award 2009" as subject of the email.
